### 1. The problem and the project area

July 2010 floods were reported to be the worst in the area since 1929 in the then Indian sub-continent. OCHA has reported that an estimated 800,000 people were in need across the country. An estimated 400,000 people have been affected in 25 districts of KPK alone. Most affected include Charsadda, Nowshera, Mansehra, Battagram, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Peshawar, Bannu, Karak, Mardan, Swat, Kohat, Dir Lower, Malakand, Hangu, Shangla, Upper Dir, D.I.Khan & Kohistan. People have been affected through socio-economic and environmental implications. There was a harmful effect on their property, environmental degradation, shortage of food and other basic needs. Huge numbers of people have been displaced from their place of origin. Initially it was difficult to access all affected areas because the roads were damaged and bridges went away with flood water. Crops have been destroyed affected the livelihood.

Prior to floods, people of these areas used to store grains, a fruit etc for their usage as well as a good quantity of fruit was exported to different countries providing sufficient cash to dwellers. Now food security is a severe problem as communities have to harvest and store their wheat and other crops in a normal way, but in such a scenario, they could not store their own food and have to rely on external support.

Eight months after floods damaged and washed away homes and livelihoods in Nowshera- Charsadda KPK Pakistan, the emergency is far from over. But thousands of people are still in urgent need of humanitarian aid and funding for early recovery projects to help rebuild their lives and livelihood. The floods were the worst in history, triggered by unusually heavy monsoon rains. Government and other humanitarian agencies jointly attempted to tackle the situation but due to limited recourses against huge level devastation the situation is still demanding. The project is very effective in local context as it was the choice for right holders to fulfill their prioritize need.

Village Shahi Klai is one of the severely affected areas of Union Council Tarnab, district Charsada in KP, which was selected for project interventions through this support. In total 5,312 flood affected families of district Charsada and Nowshera received financial assistance through similar cash for choice intervention, through support of other donors.

These village is totally dependent on agriculture and main source of income are from crops like sugar cane, wheat, vegetables and rice besides pulses and livestock. Flood caused all these sources to go washed away and dwellers of the community had to migrate to other areas to protect their lives. Heavy siltation piled onto the fertile lands of these areas turned barren wastelands. The flood badly affects the livelihood of those peoples. Their houses and other belongings were collapsed and swept away. For further reflection see Annex A-1

## **2. Selection Criteria**

Affected families who were affected by flood and were living in poor hygienic conditions and exposed to harsh weather. Destitute, women headed households and households with disable persons, sick and elders were preferred. The selected beneficiaries were in high demand. Preference was given to the household with poor income sources. HQMCs recommendation was a must for selection, but it was ensured that the recommendation was based on the above criteria.

## **3. Process Followed**

- A quick assessment conducted for the immediate needs of the affected people.
- Selection of villages for cash grant.
- Formation of Humanitarian Quality Management Committees (HQMCs), for assessment and ensuring transparency and accountability.
- Training the team in assessment and identification of the beneficiaries.
- Recording information on triplicate form, duly signed by the committee members. One leaf to be remained with the beneficiary.
- Issuance of tokens with CNIC number, location and family numbers of the concerned beneficiaries.
- Verification through monitoring visit of senior management.

## **4. Assessment**

An assessment survey was conducted by a team consisting of men and women staff members of Sungi, with support of HQMCs. In total 46 Households were identified for assistance.



## 5. Distribution of Cash Grant

Based on the detailed assessment survey, 46 beneficiaries were selected for cash grant. Arrangements were made with Muslim Commercial Bank in Charsadda for delivering in the cash to the beneficiaries.



## 6. Beneficiaries Detail

Forty six beneficiaries were provided with cash grant through the fund of this project. The list of the beneficiaries is given below. Disbursement was made at Muslim Commercial Bank Charsadda, through order cheques, and all beneficiaries received cash in presence of Sungi team members.

It is worth mentioning that 78% of the cheques were received by women. Out of **46** household **7** were headed by widows and 6 were having disabled household members. A scanned copy of the signed beneficiary list is attached as annexure.
