

# INDIVIDUAL DONATIONS PROJECT JAFFARABAD-BALUCHISTAN

(August 2010 February 2011)

Like the rest of the country district Jaffarabad Balochistan was also affected by the flood. District Jaffarabad consists of four tehsils and 46 union councils. Flood affected 38 union councils including district headquarter Dera Allahyar. In the early days of flood Sungi Development Foundation teams provided cooked food among 1000 individuals for a week in the month of August 2010, food packages were also distributed to 200 families. In the month of November Sungi Development Foundation formally started its operations in tehsil Usta Muhammad (UC Sameji) and tehsil Gandakha (UC Karia Feri). Through this project Sungi provided food items, 1300 blankets, 59 tents, 40 hand pumps, 40 safe latrines and 2 medical camps for 1300 families. Awareness raising health and hygiene sessions were also conducted on better hygiene practices. 40 latrines were installed to prevent open defection and reduce spreading diseases. 40 hand pumps were installed to provide safe drinking water to the flood affected people. 59 Tents provided to the most vulnerable shelter less people to protect them from very cold weather in the month of January. Two medical camps were also held at union councils Karia Feri and Sameji for the flood affected population. This support helped the affectees to get out of distress and enabled them to come back to their normal life.
