

FEED THE CHILDREN UK AND INDIVIDUAL DONATIONS PROJECT RAJANPUR

September 2010- January 2011

The flood water swept away houses and thousands of shelter less people became exposed to the hot and dry weather in August 2010, outbreak of water borne diseases and shortage of food items. Responding to the situation Sungi Development Foundation sent its assessment team in Rajanpur district to assess the extent of damage and designed a project to provide emergency food, clothing and hygiene needs of the people in Sahan Wala, Kotla Mughala and Noor Pur Machi Wala union councils of district Rajanpur. Throughout the project period, Sungi's teams distributed 1105 Aqua boxes, 536 food packages and 760 clothes and blankets among 1892 families. Wall chalking was done on different points highlighting the messages about health & hygiene, education and safe construction. This support helped the affectees specially children and women to overcome some of the trauma and enabling them to come back to a semblance of normal life.
